**2001**

1. Developed a partnership with Ivy Tech Community College and St Catherine's hospital to provide classes for Community Health Workers. First students attended class in the fall of 2001.
2. Began the "Living for Life" program in Starke County. Partnerships were developed with local churches and community centers to provide exercise and nutrition programs to fight heart disease.
3. HVM provided office space and support for the Minority Organ Tissue Transplant Education Program (MOTTEP).
4. Received a grant of \$30,000 to hire an educator to provide workshops for childcare directors on health, nutrition and lead poisoning education.
5. On November 8, 2001 HVM received the "Lead-Safe Indiana" award for leadership and innovative work in community activism and coalition building to prevent child lead poisoning in Lake and Allen Counties.
